Cultural Programme

- Changes in China: How does individuation touch the culture?
- Spiritual processes in Chinese traditional thoughts
- The Oedipus complex in China: Psychoanalytic interpretation of the film 'Hero' by Zhang Yimou (Tomas Plaenkers, German Ass.)
- Social customs in old China; a psychoanalytic interpretation of 'The return of the Red Lantern' by Zhang Yimou (Alf Gerlach, German Ass.)
- Historical memories and personal memories in the filmography of Zhang Yimou (Simonetta Diena, Italian Society)

The Conference is open to IPA members and candidates, to members and candidates of the Psychoanalytic Institute of Eastern Europe (Siberia, Georgia, Armenia and Kazakhstan) and to psychotherapists, psychiatrists and mental health professional from all Asian countries.
